## Purpose

These are activities for parents to complete with their child. Facilitators support and encourage the interaction while helping deepen the learning experience for both.

## Scope and Sequence

The manuals are organized into units based on developmental age and should be tailored to each child's individual needs. The Three-Year-Old manuals include Unit 1 (Young Threes: 37–42 months) and Unit 2 (Older Threes: 43–48 months). The Four-Year-Old manuals include Unit 1 (Young Fours: 49–54 months) and Unit 2 (Older Fours: 55–60 months). Each unit offers activities aligned to key learning domains and appropriate for that developmental stage.



## Materials

The activities require minimal supplies, most of which are easily accessible. Parents learn that meaningful learning and fun can be created with everyday materials they already have on hand.

## Development

These activities were created by people who do exactly what home visitors do. Much thought has gone into what works to engage parents and their children in lots of joyful, home-based interaction.
